## Critically III CoVID-19 patient with shock

- Remdesvir and Decadron as per COVID 19 therapeutic guidelines
- Consider Convalescent Plasma as per your Institution guidelines
- Broad spectrum antibiotics if bacterial infection is suspected
- If patient is in Shock- place CVC (Central Venus Cather) for vasopressors. Consider placing Arterial line
- Conservative fluid strategy( studies has shown net negative fluid strategy in severe patients has good prognosis) Consider Diamox or Lasix for fluid conservative strategy)
- Recommended Crystalloids over Colloids for shock
- Norepinephrine is the first line of vasopressors for fluid unresponsive shock
- Vasopressin is an alternative agent and can add as a second agent to Norepinephrine
- Shock with evidence of cardiac dysfunction can add Dobutamine to Norepinephrine
- Titrate Vasopressors to maintain MAP of 60-65
